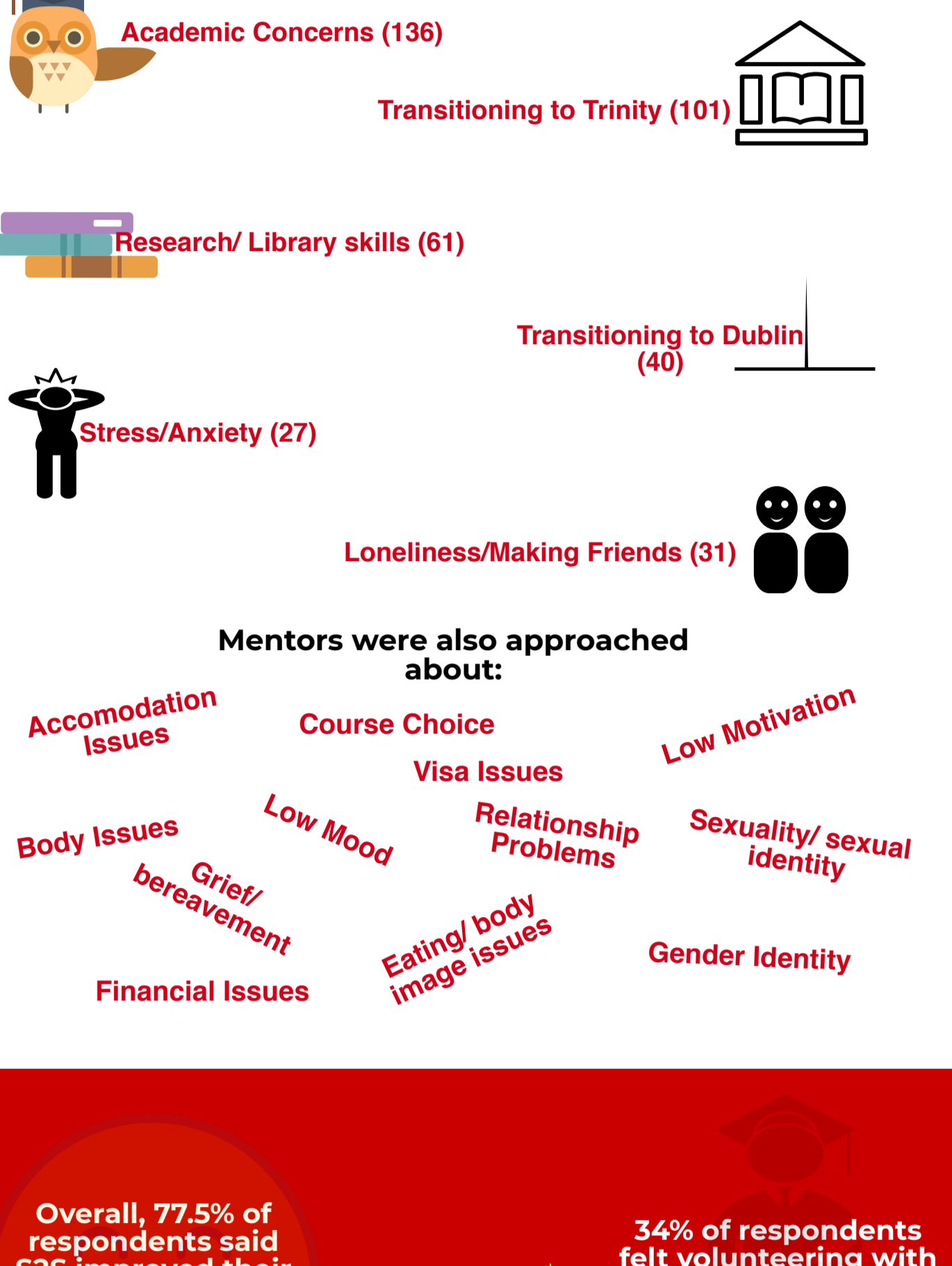
164 Volunteers responded to our survey, below are the role(s) they undertook (some volunteers may have had more than one role)

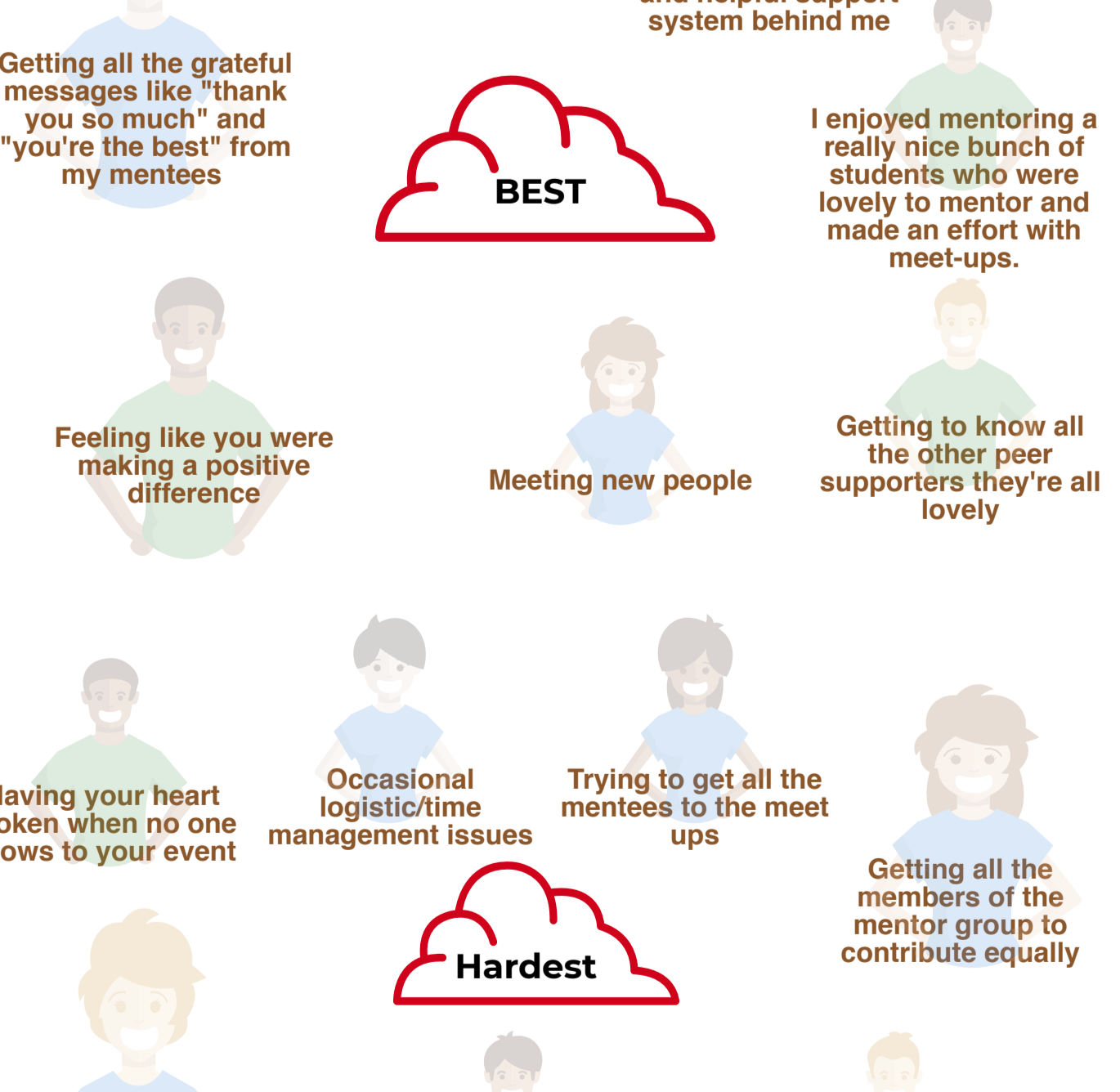
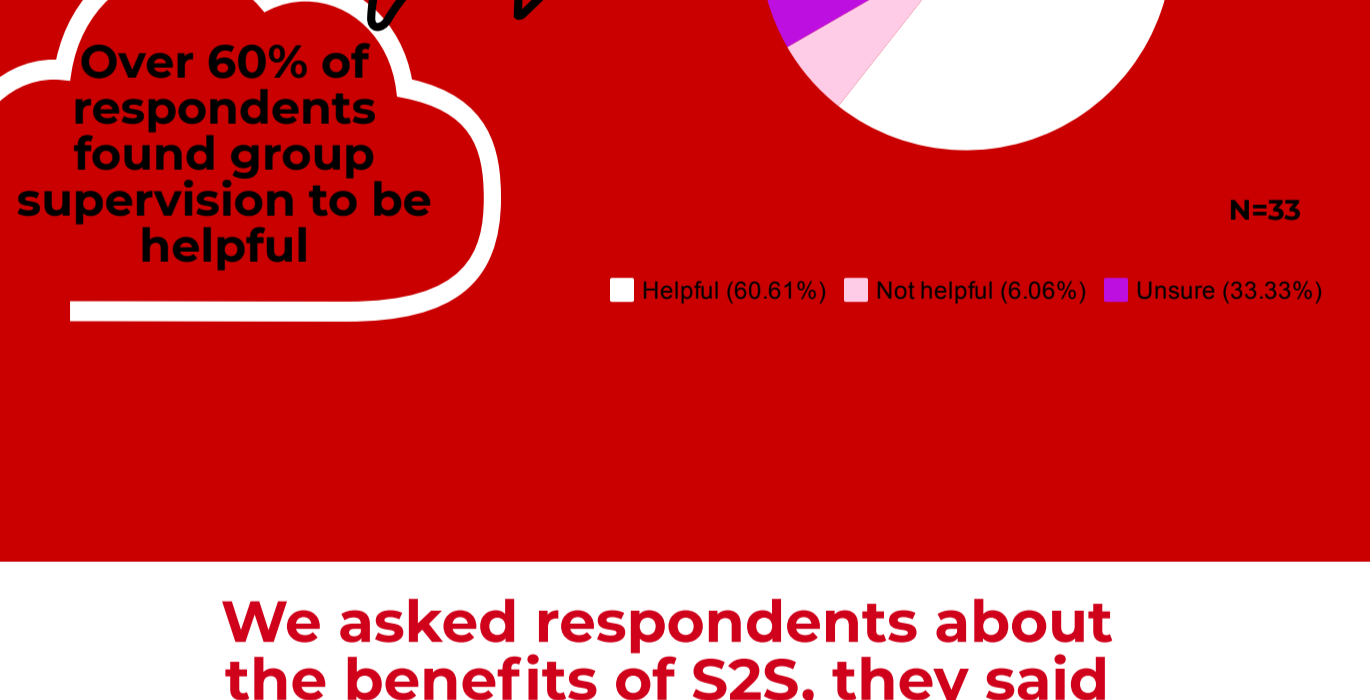
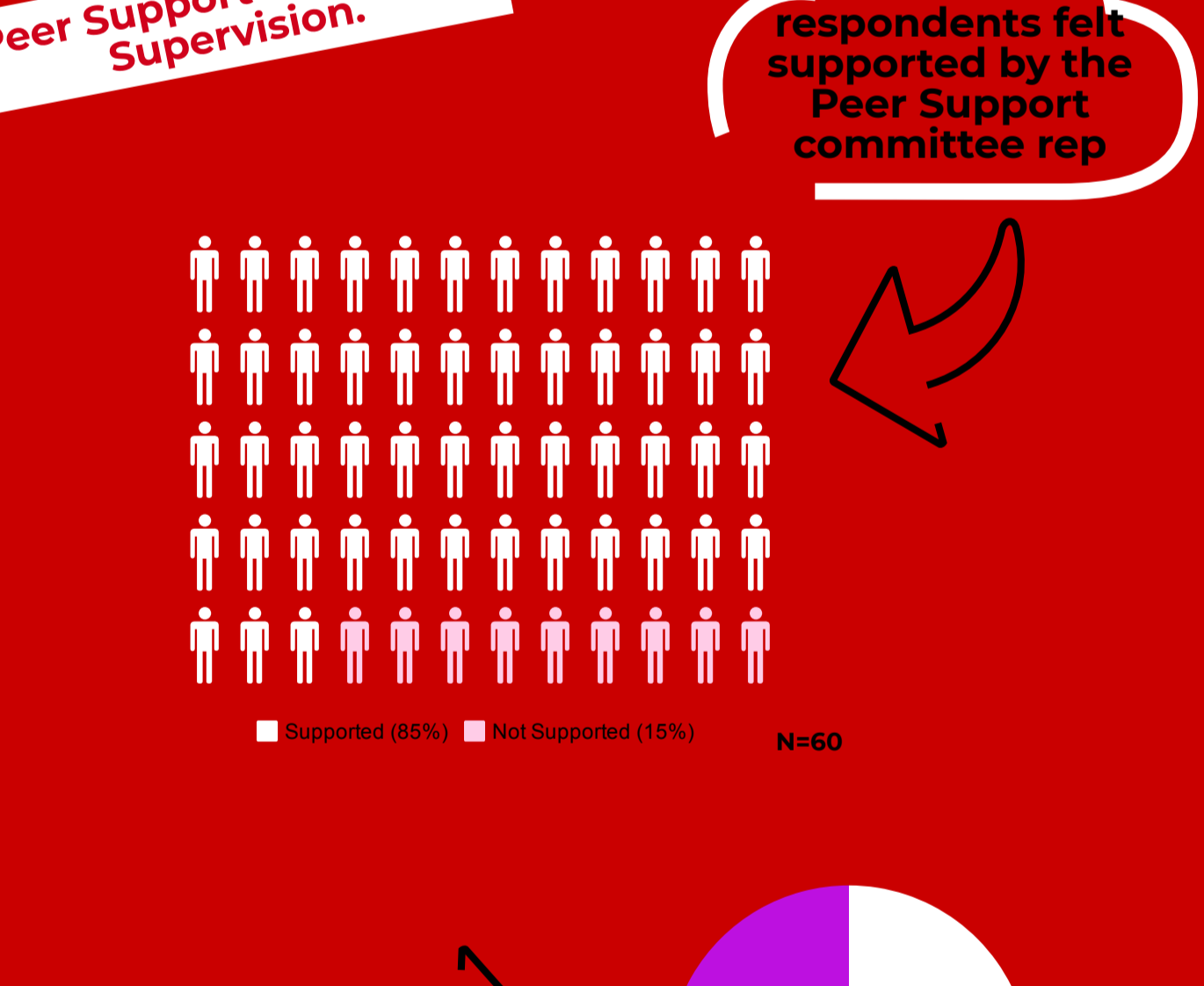
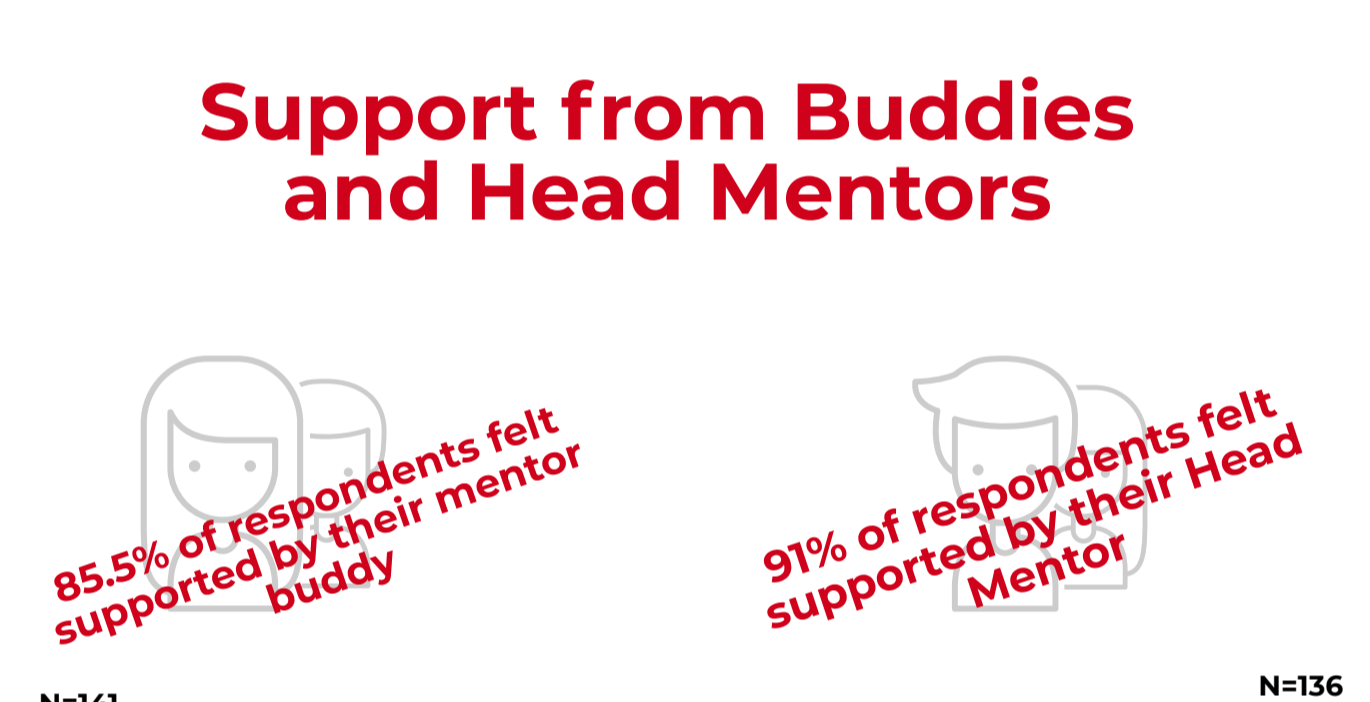
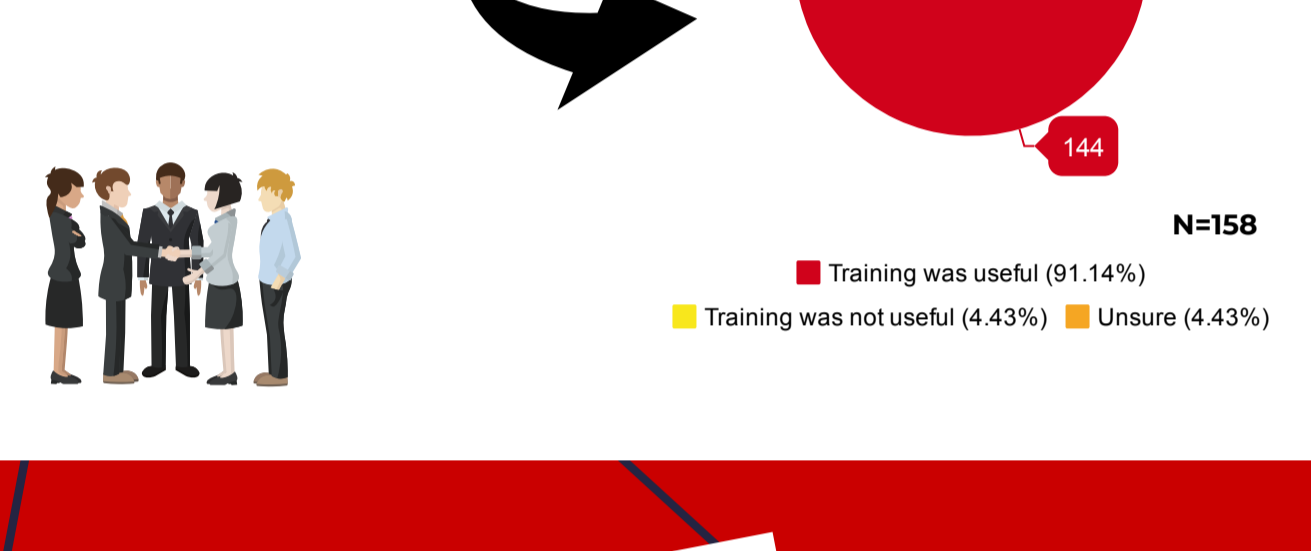


Main Areas of Concern for First Years
